

# A rural apiary inspector's kit checklist:

- clean veil, protective clothing (extra socks, chemical gloves, etc.)
- hive tools, fence tester
- smoker(s), fuel, igniters in a metal container
- flat toothpicks, thumb tacks, strike-anywhere matches
- pocket tin, duct tape, clean foam scraps, flagging tape
- spare JZBZ queen cage, queen marking paint
- paper & plastic bags for samples, garbage bags
- reading glasses, magnifier
- camera & or cell phone w/extra batteries, charger
- Varroa mite monitoring supplies (alcohol wash, icing sugar shake, cappings fork, sticky board)
- wash water, 70% rubbing alcohol, paper towels
- propane torch, fire extinguisher, brush
- First Aid kit – sunscreen, liquid Benadryl, scissors, etc.
- CAPA Honey Bee Disease & Pest booklet, Bulletin handouts
- clipboard, paperwork, pens, felt markers, notebook
- drinking water & a high protein snack...tunes, and so on.
